

**SB 1113 (California Budget Act, Chapter 208 of the Statutes of 2004) –
One Time Allocation of \$30,000,000 for the purchase of supplementary materials for
English Learners (EL)**

Important Dates and Guidelines for Your School's Submission:

Important Deadlines:

- March 31, 2005, an LEA (Local Educational Agency) must submit an “intent to purchase” that is very specific.
- June 30, 2006, an LEA must encumber any funds it has been allocated

Include this information in your “intent to purchase”:

- Number of English learners you are serving, up to the certified number of English learners as reported in Language Census 2004.
- Product you intend to purchase:

- Grade levels to serve
