

Getting Started with *Unique Reader's* Online Instruction

Unique Reader is an add-on instructional component available to students who have completed Let's Go Learn's *DORA*. After students have completed *DORA*, they will automatically be assigned to the appropriate level in the 4 strands of instruction in *Unique Reader*: Phonics, Sight Words, Vocabulary, and Comprehension.

- Students upon completion of the assessment will be logged out. They will need to log back in to transition into instruction.
- Lesson positions are remembered so that the next time the student logs in, the instructional system will begin on the same activity.

Click on the **<URead>** tab via the teacher account to see the screen (shown below). From here, you can turn instruction on or off, change the levels of the lessons assigned, and monitor your students' performance on lessons.

<Instruction On or Off>

On - This means that instruction is turned on for this student.

When an assessment is completed, the student will automatically transition into instruction at the appropriate lesson as listed in the 4 tracks of reading instruction columns. Any time a student logs in remotely, he or she will automatically resume instruction where they left off. Clicking the "ON" link will turn instruction "OFF".

Click on the **<Help>** link under each column to learn more about that option.

<Instruction Start>

Links in this column allow you to immediately begin or continue instruction.

* - An asterisk means that the student is not able to start instruction.

<Student Log>

The "detail" link in this column will show you all of the activities that each student has completed on which date. It will provide scores and times if applicable to the lesson.

<list> takes you to a detailed lesson overview page for each individual track. From here, you can sample each lesson to see what is presented in the lesson, review, and activity that will be presented to the student.

Clicking **<Change>** will activate any changes that you make to the student's lesson placement. Either type in a valid lesson number or "dn" into the form fields under the 4 instruction track columns.

[All Instruction On](#) [All Instruction Off](#)

These numbers or symbols indicate which lesson the student has been assigned to in each track following the assessment.

"dn" in any column indicates that instruction is turned off for that track. Either the student has finished all lessons in that track or that they received a score on the assessment that placed them above the level of activities available in that track.

* - An asterisk means that the student is not able to start instruction for that particular track.

The reason could be any of the following: Instruction is turned off; an assessment has not been completed; or the student is in the process of taking an assessment.

"All Instruction On" and "All Instruction Off"

Clicking these buttons will turn instruction either ON or OFF for ALL students at once.
